CONCUSSION RISK MANAGEMENT POLICY

This Policy is designed to ensure that Sporting Clays Western Australia Association, Board, committee members, Clubs and members of the Clubs are aware of the obligations, responsibilities and duty of care required in an area that may or may not directly affect our sport regardless if involved in competition of Sporting Clays shooting or in the field whilst involved in hunting and habitat feral animal management control.

Being that shooting is an outdoor oriented sport with many different terrains and construction materials involved, it is conceivable that the possibility for a Member to have an accident involving falling and concussion. Therefore, this Policy is introduced to provide a pathway to counteract and monitor such instances.

Member tripping over uneven ground around Club or Range area	Falling only involved	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Member to advise Club of incident • Club to check the status of person involved and ensure ability to continue. • Follow up to check on wellbeing of member.
Member tripping over uneven ground around Club or Range area	Falling with head hitting ground	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Club to check the status of person involved Identify if medical assistance needed for severity and degree of contact with ground • Decision on ability to continue with competition or practice • Incident to be recorded by Club and SCWA Safety Officer to be informed. Follow up to check on wellbeing of member.
Member tripping over uneven ground around Club or Range area	Falling with head hitting ground whereby unconscious	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Club to check the status of person involved • Call for medical assistance if available on ground or ambulance • Decision on ability to continue with competition or practice after medical intervention • Incident to be recorded by Club and SCWA Safety Officer to be informed. Follow up to check on wellbeing of member.
